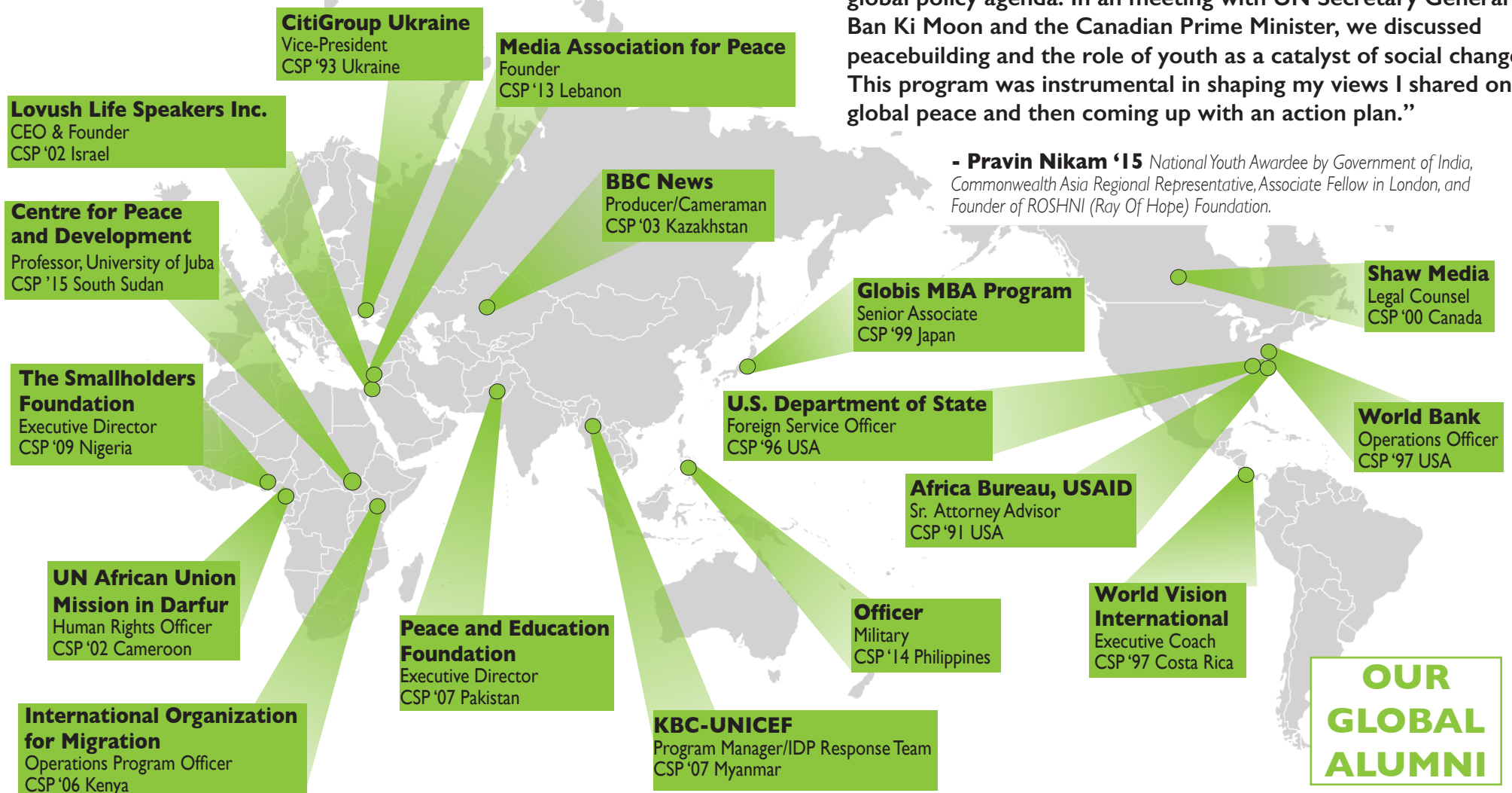


Caux Scholars Program
